The Honorable Cecil H. Underwood, Republican nominee for Governor, was guest speaker following lunch today. Governor Underwood served as a member of the West Virginia Legislature for twelve years and was Governor of West Virginia from 1956-1960. He is a former counselor of Mountaineer Boys' State. He was accompanied to Jackson's Mill by his son Craig and David Baker, a Huntington lawyer.

Miller who announced that the West Virginia Boys' State exchange citizen who will attend the Canadian camp comparable to our Boys' State at Sir James Whitney School in Belleville, Ontario, Canada, will be Dennis Owen Rexroad (Panhandle - Vienna). In the event that he cannot attend, the designated alternate is Michael Lee Hogan (Barbour - St. Albans).
