

<u>SCHOOL RESPONSIBILITIES – ACTION STEPS</u>

Complete by November 11, 2025:

- 1. Submit a School Point of Contact (POC):
 - Email the POC's name, title, email address, and phone number to almbs@wvboysstate.org.
- 2. Submit a List of Eligible Candidates:
 - Export a list of all eligible junior mail students from WVEIS or your school's data management system in Microsoft Excel or a comma delimited file (CSV).
 - Email the list of all eligible students (including full name, mailing address, and phone number) to almbs@wvboysstate.org.
- 3. Contact Your Local ALMBS Representative:
 - If you have questions, reach out to your local representative regarding the 2026 program. If you do not have a known local ALMBS Representative, a point of contact in your region is listed on the final page.

Complete by January 19, 2026:

- 4. Direct Eligible Candidates to Apply:
 - Instruct interested students to complete the online application at https://apply.wvboysstate.org.
- 5. Collect Applications:
 - Gather completed applications from students for final review by the school POC.

Complete by February 9, 2026:

- 6. Submit Completed Applications:
 - Provide all completed applications to your local ALMBS Representative.

STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES – ACTION STEPS

Complete by January 19, 2026:

Complete an application found online at https://apply.wvboysstate.org, and return it to school POC.

In March/April 2026:

 Selected attendees receive ALMBS informational packets explaining program details, required forms, and other relevant program information.

In May 2026:

• Attend a virtual or in-person orientation session. A schedule of virtual sessions will be provided in the distributed participant informational packets.

On June 7th through June 13th, 2026:

 Attend the 87th session of The American Legion Mountaineer Boys State program. All Participants are expected to be present for the entirety of the program.

ALMBS OVERVIEW

ALMBS Participants Discover Their Leadership Potential!

ALMBS is a week-long, hands-on leadership and government program for high school junior males in West Virginia. Since 1936, ALMBS has helped thousands of students build confidence, make lifelong friends, and gain real-world experience in government, law, public service, and citizenship.

Why Should Students Attend?

- **Experience Government in Action:** Run for office, pass laws, and make decisions in a simulated state government. Witness the effects these laws and decisions have on the simulated community.
- **Build Their Network:** Meet motivated students from across West Virginia and connect with elected officials and professionals.
- **Boost Their College and Career Prospects:** Gain eligibility for scholarships, earn extra merit points for military academy admissions, and stand out on college applications.
- **Explore Careers:** Try out career tracks in law enforcement, journalism, homeland security, emergency services, business, and more. Attend a private collegiate and career fair to develop post high school plans.
- Have Fun: Enjoy sports, music, and recreational activities throughout the week.

ALMBS is nonpartisan and has no association with any real-world political parties or their platforms. All eligible students are welcome! If they want to challenge themself, grow as a leader, and make a difference, this is their opportunity!

QUALIFICATIONS

ALMBS is open to all those meeting the requirements below regardless of race, color, religion, disability, political affiliation, socioeconomic status, or national origin.

Individuals who possess the following qualifications are eligible to apply for admission to ALMBS:

- 1. Member of the male enrollment of the current junior class;
- 2. 2.75 grade point average (GPA) or higher on a four-point scale; (Note: Schools should use the most current cumulative GPA as of their response.)
- 3. Good personal character, ensuring he will effectively represent himself and uphold the esteem of his local school/community;
- 4. Never attended an American Legion Boys State program previously; and
- 5. Citizen of West Virginia OR attend a high school in West Virginia.


Tax Deductible:
